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Gateway

Gateway is a work based programme where students are placed in suitable workplace in the industry area of their choice.

Gateway helps students to get a realistic view of the industry they are interested in and complete credits associated with the programme. A placement is a minimum of one day a week for 10 weeks.

Employment

Cambridge High School is able to help students with entering the workforce through brokering work placements, interviews and CV help. Depending on student maturity some may be offered work experience.

Primary Industries Trade Academy

Year 11-13 students wanting to explore the career opportunities within Primary Industries may get an opportunity for a hands on approach to give them real life experiences. One day a week – limited numbers.

Wintec Trades Academy

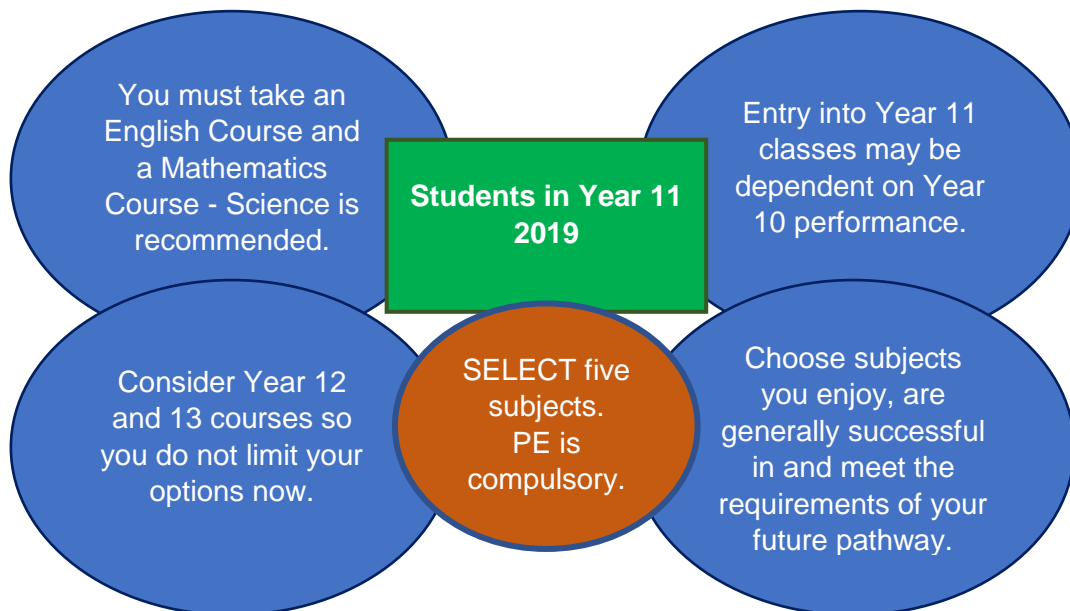
The Waikato Trades Academy (WTA) is a secondary-tertiary partnership which allows year 11, 12 and 13 students to study at Wintec while still at school.

The WTA gives students a head start gaining specific and practical experience and skills in an industry based setting and the opportunity to move directly into a job or apprenticeship, or further study on completion of school.

The Academy provides sector related credits required to earn a Vocational Pathway Award on your NCEA Level 2 and NCEA Level 3 qualifications.
