SAILING AT CHS

Cambridge Yacht Club is pleased to announce that registrations are now open for the new Youth Sailing Programme.

The **Cambridge Youth 420 Sailing Programme** invites 2019 Year 7 through 13 students who are interested in learning how to sail and develop their sailing skills, to join the youth sailing programme. This programme has the aim of making sailing more accessible and fun in a supportive team learning environment.

Students will learn from experienced sailors in the programme, sailing in a fleet of eight purpose built two-handed race training yachts, which focus on teamwork and learning from each other. All aspects of dinghy sailing are taught, including sailing knots, parts of a boat, maritime safety, and dinghy racing. No sailing experience is required, with a willingness to learn new skills and to work hard being the only requirements.

This is not solely a Cambridge High School training programme and is open to students from any school. The goal will be to enter CHS teams in the regional team sailing regatta and a team in the national secondary school team sailing championship.
