Services Industries



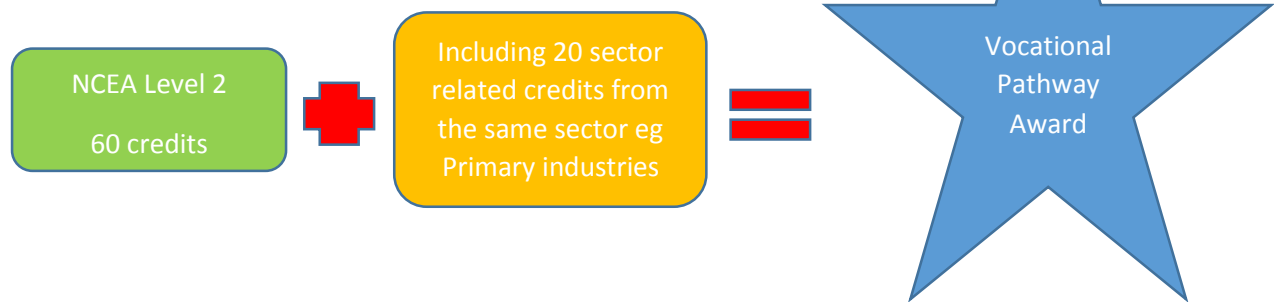
