# Senior Parent Teacher Interviews


The Senior Parent / Teacher interviews will be held on **Thursday 4 April** from 3pm until 6.30pm.

#### **NCEA Co-requisite Assessments**

Our first round of Literacy and Numeracy Co-requisite assessments will take place next term from 28 – 30 May. We have little flexibility over these dates so it is important to take note of this.

Parents of Yr 10 students will have received an email with information about the significance, selection of students, and preparation for these assessments. Parents of Yr 11 students yet to gain Literacy and/or Numeracy will receive this email shortly.

The Literacy Co-requisite Teams will be live from Monday, 25 March so students can access resources independently. These include access to Education Perfect with Co-requisite specific reading and writing tasks for students to work through. Writer's Toolbox is available to Yr 10 students and has a range of tutorials that teach and scaffold the knowledge and skills needed. Teachers across all learning areas are reinforcing the reading and writing skills and knowledge that are required to achieve the standards within their subject areas.

Skills and content knowledge for the Numeracy Co-requisite is taught and tested by the Numeracy specific tasks on Education Perfect. These will be reinforced and scaffolded in many learning areas and in the Maths classrooms.

We wish all our students well as they work constructively towards preparing for these important assessments.

Working in partnership with Te Whatu Ora, our aim is to improve the number of high school students accessing quality dental care.

This is your opportunity to enrol your adolescent with us for their **free dental care**. We will see students from **years 9 to 13 (under 18 years old)** for their free dental check-up and treatment.

If your adolescent is currently enrolled with a dental provider, please let us know. Just click the link below and choose the "No" option if you're happy to stay with them.

Your child's first appointment with us will consist of:

- Full examination of teeth and overall oral health
- X-rays
- Preventive treatments as needed, including:
  - Simple clean
  - Fissure sealants
  - Application of topical fluoride
  - Simple fillings as needed (parental consent may be required)

We will then continue see your child yearly for their dental consultation until their 18th birthday, unless you inform us otherwise.

We are long-time members of the New Zealand Dental Association and strictly adhere to best clinical practices and health and safety policies. We operate with the highest level of integrity, safety, efficiency, and privacy.

All Dental Planet staff working in our mobile units undergo in depth training to ensure they are constantly up to date with the current protocols for each school we serve. Police vetting is mandatory and CCTV cameras are positioned inside the mobile units to safeguard both patients and staff.
