

Dental care is free for NZ residents under 18 years old and we provide public-funded dental care on-site at many high schools in Auckland, Northland and Waikato. Working in partnership with Te Whatu Ora, our aim is to improve the number of high school students accessing quality dental care.

This is your opportunity to enrol your adolescent with us for their **free dental care**. We will see students from **years 9 to 13 (under 18 years old)** for their free dental check-up and treatment.

If your adolescent is currently enrolled with a dental provider, please let us know. Just click the link below and choose the "No" option if you're happy to stay with them.

Your child's first appointment with us will consist of:

- Full examination of teeth and overall oral health
- X-rays
- Preventive treatments as needed, including:
 - Simple clean
 - Fissure sealants
 - Application of topical fluoride
 - Simple fillings as needed (parental consent may be required)

We will then continue see your child yearly for their dental consultation until their 18th birthday, unless you inform us otherwise.

We are long-time members of the New Zealand Dental Association and strictly adhere to best clinical practices and health and safety policies. We operate with the highest level of integrity, safety, efficiency, and privacy.

All Dental Planet staff working in our mobile units undergo in depth training to ensure they are constantly up to date with the current protocols for each school we serve. Police vetting is mandatory and CCTV cameras are positioned inside the mobile units to safeguard both patients and staff.

Waikato Inter-Collegiate Teams Day


Held on 13 May at Matamata Golf Club
