



- Know your NSN number and NZQA login details,
- If you don't have your own device, there are back-up devices available.

POLLY

- Polly is a text to speech tool that will read the text aloud to you.
- Polly is built into the platform and can read for you for Numeracy and the Writing Literacy exam.
- Bring your headphones to the exam!

NCEA Corner

Co-requisite Assessments Term 2

Yr 10, 11, 12 and 13 students who are entered into one or more of the Common Assessment Activities (CAA) to gain their Literacy and Numeracy co-requisites in Week 5 next term, and their parents have been emailed to confirm this.

This is an important opportunity to gain these co-requisites that must be achieved in order to be awarded any further NCEA qualification. It is in our students' best interests to gain these co-requisites through the CAAs so that all their Level 1, 2 or 3 credits count towards their total NCEA credits for a level qualification.

Students have access to resources in Teams for reading and writing, and from their Maths teachers for numeracy. Yr 10 students and Yr 11 ENT students also have access to Writer's Toolbox with its great range of tutorials and daily challenges. These are available during the holidays and into Term 2.

Students gain confidence and experience by working through tasks and past assessments that are similar to the questions they will face in in Week 5 next term.

LearnCoach

Additional Online Tuition Resource for Yr 11 - 13

LearnCoach is a New Zealand based company that has been offering students online access to NCEA support since 2012. They have now added Ai tutoring to their offering of popular videos, guides, resource materials, and practice questions. There are resources available that cover a wide range of subjects and NCEA achievement standards, with more being added regularly.

For 2025 CHS has accepted an offer from LearnCoach for all Year 11-13 students to have access to the LearnCoach programme between 8.30-3.30 Mon-Fri and an additional 60 minutes a day outside of school hours. In addition to this self-directed time, teachers also have the ability to

set tasks for students that they are able to complete at any time. Access to these free accounts is available during terms 1-3 and is a great resource for students to use as they learn material and prepare for internal assessments.

All Cambridge High School senior students have access to this free account and can activate their accounts by going to <https://learncoach.com/>, selecting register and complete the registration process using their school email address. Over 200 CHS students have already activated their accounts and have started using these resources.

We hope this addition tool in the kit is helpful as students work towards their NCEA goals.

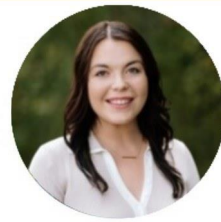

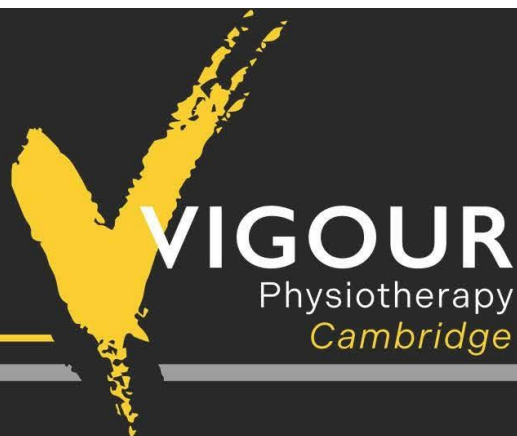
