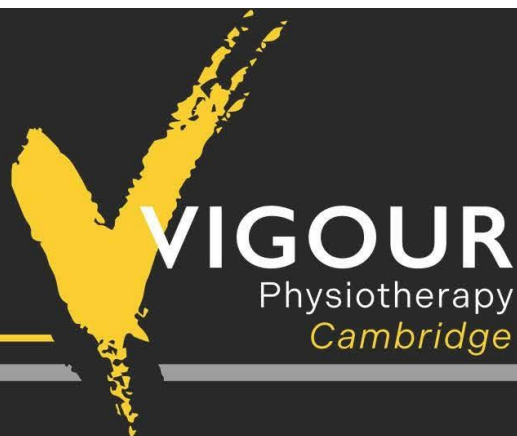
Homestay Families Required
