

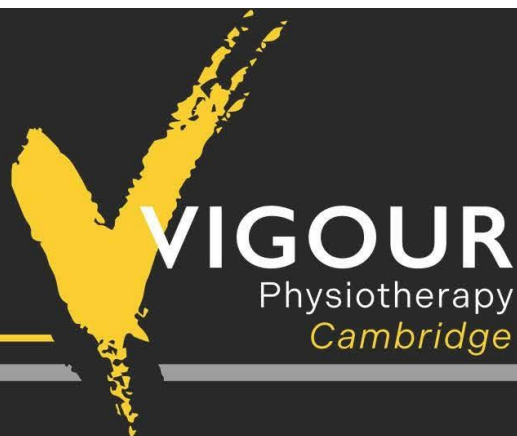
Homestay Families Required
