



CAMBRIDGE HIGH SCHOOL CHS ROWING

The fees for the Cambridge High School Rowing season 2021/22 are as follows:

- Returning rowers \$2,200.
- Novices \$2,200 – Includes rowing polo and cap or visor.
- Coxswains \$1,000 – Includes coxes jacket.
- Camps – \$150 per camp – Must be paid prior to camp.
- Maadi Cup Twizel \$2,500 - (indicative only).

A deposit of \$500 (\$250 coxes) is required by 28th September (returning athletes) and 22nd October 2021 (novice athletes) to confirm your commitment to row this season. These fees are paid to the school using the following methods of payment:

A payment plan form will be issued with the health and registration forms shortly. This must be completed and signed indicating how you will be paying for the remaining fees. This will include options for:

1. **Lump Sum.**
2. **4 Equal Monthly Payments over 4 Months.**
3. **Weekly Payments over 16 Weeks.**

All fees are to be paid in full by February 20th, 2022

What do my Rowing Fees Cover?

There are many expenses to running a rowing club below is an idea of some of those expenses. You will note that rowing fees **do not go towards capital expenditure such as the purchase of new boats, oars, coach boats or other coaching aides**. We rely on community sponsorship, grants and fundraising to cover these costs. Fees also **do not go towards attending the New Zealand Secondary Schools Rowing Champs (Maadi Cup)**, this is funded separately by the athletes selected to attend as well as community sponsorship.

Regatta Entry Fees (28%)

- Entry Fee (based on boat size) \$28.75 average per race.
- Amenity Fee \$16.10 per athlete, per regatta.
- Seat Levy \$1.38 per athlete, per race.
- Late Scratching Penalty \$46 per race.
- Tent Site \$215 per regatta.

Subscriptions (13%)

- Rowing New Zealand \$80.
- Cambridge Rowing Club \$145.
- Waikato Rowing Association Levy \$25.

Repairs & Maintenance (18%)

- Re-shafting broken oars.
- Refurbishment of boats.
- Repair of damage to boats.
- Erg services.
- Coach boat services & trailer WOF.
- Coach boat safety equipment.
- Lightbulbs, batteries, tools for the shed.
- New equipment for boats such as slides, shoes.
- Cox boxes – replacement, repairs & maintenance.
- Stroke coaches.

Coaching Expenses (38%)

- Coaching courses.
- Donation to coaches.
- Program Co-Ordinator wages.
- Fuel for the coach boats.

Administration (3%)

- Printing of the handbook and any other printed material.
- Cleaning equipment.
- End of season prizegiving & AGM expenses.
- Courier expenses for uniforms.
- Photographer.
- Committee funded events.
- First Aid kits.
