NCEA Corner

Senior students are heading into derived grade exams in Week 8. The exams commence **Thursday 4 September** and finish on Tuesday **16 September**.

The exams provide students with an excellent opportunity to revise and practice for their external examinations, as well as giving them a derived grade should they need it for compassionate grounds. Students need to arrive for these exams prepared with the following equipment:

1. For digital exams, a fully charged and updated device.
2. Correct subject equipment including pens, pencils, calculators etc.
3. The exams are full NCEA rules so no watches, phones etc. Equipment needs to be in a clear plastic bag (zip lock bags are great) and any drink bottles must be clear with no writing.
4. Photo ID such as student ID or a drivers license.

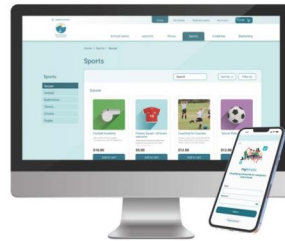

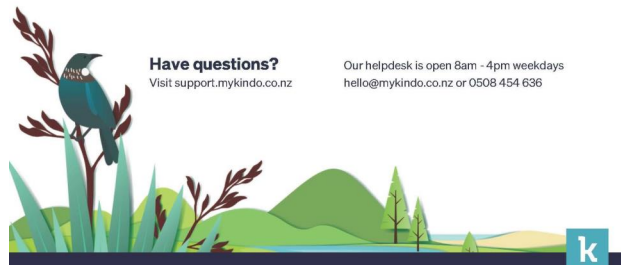

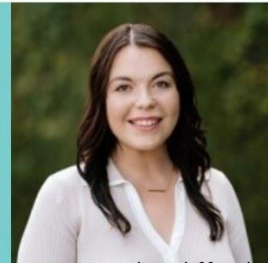

Students are welcome to come to any (or all) of the following sessions:



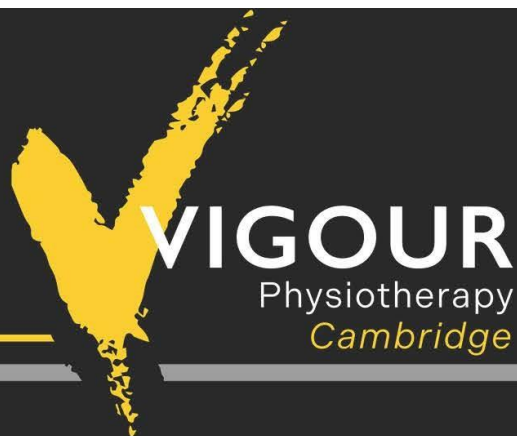
