## NCEA Corner

Senior students are heading into derived grade exams in Week 8. The exams commence **Thursday 4 September** and finish on Tuesday **16 September**. Students return to school on Wednesday 17 September.

The exams provide students with an excellent opportunity to revise and practice for their external examinations, as well as giving them a derived grade should they need it for compassionate grounds. Students need to arrive for these exams prepared with the following equipment:

1. For digital exams, a fully charged and updated device.
2. Correct subject equipment including pens, pencils, calculators etc.
3. The exams are full NCEA rules so no watches, phones etc. Equipment needs to be in a clear plastic bag (zip lock bags are great) and any drink bottles must be clear with no writing.
4. Photo ID such as student ID or a drivers license.

## Cambridge High School Junior<sup>+</sup> Class



Our students are entering a different world to that of their parents with new job and learning opportunities. The Junior<sup>+</sup> (plus) Class is an initiative for students who wish to be involved in a mainstream class, while also being extended in a passion project/inquiry of interest of their choice. This class is suitable for motivated students who wish to be challenged and are good self-managers.

In order to give them time to focus on their projects/inquiries of interests, students will be given two one-hour blocks each week and as with our mainstream classes, they will still also attend their option subjects.

Four teachers from across the four core subjects form our Junior<sup>+</sup> teaching team and in order to allow for the project/inquiry of interest time, they will each dedicate an hour per fortnight. These teachers have also been selected for their abilities to support and inspire all learners to follow their interest.

The Junior<sup>+</sup> Class has also been designed to help develop 21st Century learners and life ready individuals and focuses on the following areas of deep learning:

- ❑ Character
- ❑ Citizenship
- ❑ Communication
- ❑ Collaboration
- ❑ Creativity
- ❑ Critical thinking

### Assessment

Students will be assessed against the same English, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies curriculum objectives as those in mainstream courses. In terms of their projects/inquiries of interest however, the students will be guided and mentored throughout the year to help see them through to completion.

### Use of technology

All students in Cambridge High School are required to have a digital device to enhance their learning. The expectation will be the same for the Junior<sup>+</sup> Class.
