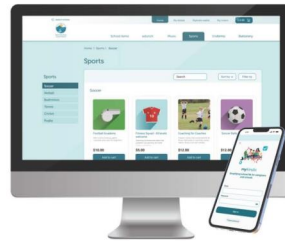

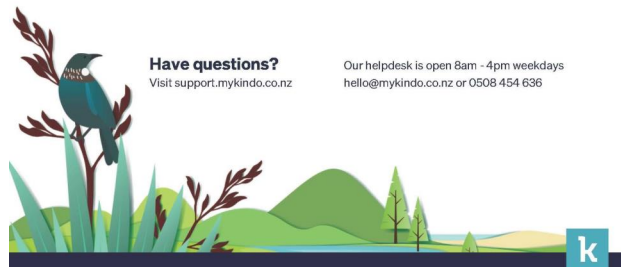



Wāipa District Council wants to hear from children and families about the future of transport.

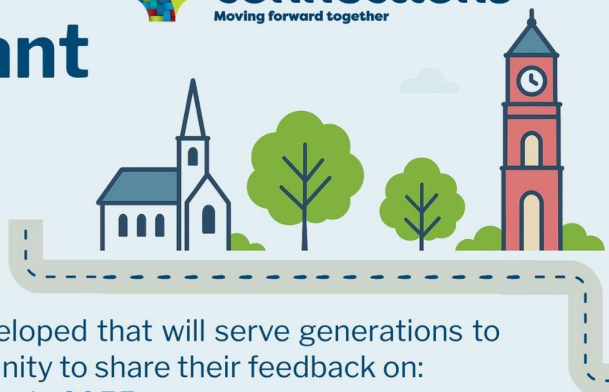
A transport plan is currently being developed that will serve generations to come. The Council is asking our community to share their feedback on:

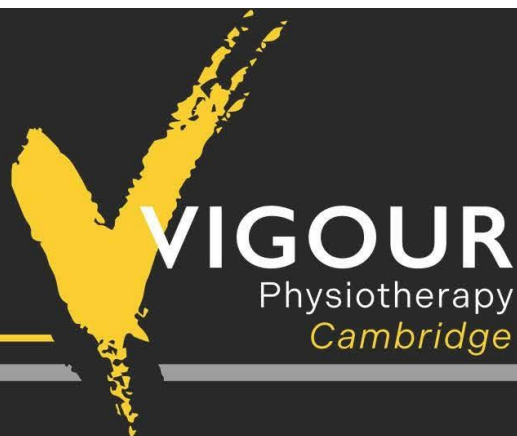
