



Sports Honours and Tie Criteria

Students will receive their Sports Honours/Tie as a recognition for excelling in their area of expertise: -

- The student will need to follow and display our **REACH** values
- Attendance Rate of at least 85%
- The student will need to show enthusiasm, outstanding involvement and spirit as a member of an extra-curricular sports team
- All awards are at the discretion of the Team Leader (Sport and Arts) and Deputy Principal (Strengthening Culture)

CHS Sports Tie

Awarded to students who have either won a New Zealand title or represented New Zealand in their chosen sport, whether through school or non-school pathways.

To be eligible, the New Zealand title or national selection must be officially recognised by the relevant national sporting governing body.

All students who represent New Zealand will also be formally acknowledged at the end-of-year Sports Awards, where they will receive a special New Zealand Representative Award.

CHS Sports Honours

This award recognises students—either individuals or teams—who have achieved outstanding results in school sport competitions.

Eligibility includes:

- Placing in the **top 3** at a **Regional Secondary Schools Championship**
- Placing in the **top 5** at a **North Island Secondary Schools event**
- Placing in the **top 8** at a **New Zealand Secondary Schools event**

To qualify, teams must have competed in **top-tier tournaments** only.

This award is also presented to students who have been selected for a **regional representative A team**.

Please note:

Achievements in non-school events are not eligible for this award. However, students may still be considered for a **Sporting Achievement Badge*** if they meet the relevant criteria.
