<p><b>MISCELLANEOUS - YR 10 BYOD</b></p> <p>NB: It is important that devices are brought to school each day.</p>	<p><b>Device - Laptop/Notebook with the following minimum specifications:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Minimum 11.6" screen</li> <li>• Sufficient storage to download and install Office 365 and Support Teams and other O365 apps (4-8GB storage)</li> <li>• A minimum of 5 hours of use from one battery charge – fully charged at home each day</li> <li>• Suitable protective case - something that will fit in a school bag and not damage the device</li> <li>• Microsoft Office 365 - this is available free for all Cambridge High School students and can be installed once term starts.</li> </ul> <p>The following are examples of devices we suggest for 2026:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• HP Notebook/Pavillion/Probook</li> <li>• Surface Pro</li> <li>• Lenovo Laptop range</li> </ul> <p>For more details regarding devices, please refer to the BYOD section of our website - <a href="https://www.camhigh.school.nz/byod/">https://www.camhigh.school.nz/byod/</a></p> <p>You are welcome to purchase either a laptop or chromebook that meets the above needs.</p> <p>We recommend that you view your child's BYOD time at CHS in two parts – the junior years and the senior years. This would mean purchasing a device now that will cater for the generic needs of the junior school and then replacing that device in the senior school (Year 11 or 12), as the demands of the learning become more obvious.
