Compuhub are arranging the best possible deal (price and support) for us on Chromebooks and will be in touch with our community shortly.</p> <p>We recommend that you view your child's BYOD time at CHS in two parts – the junior years and the senior years. This would mean purchasing a device now that will cater for the generic needs of the junior school and then replacing that device in the senior school (Year 11 or 12), as the demands of the learning become more obvious.
