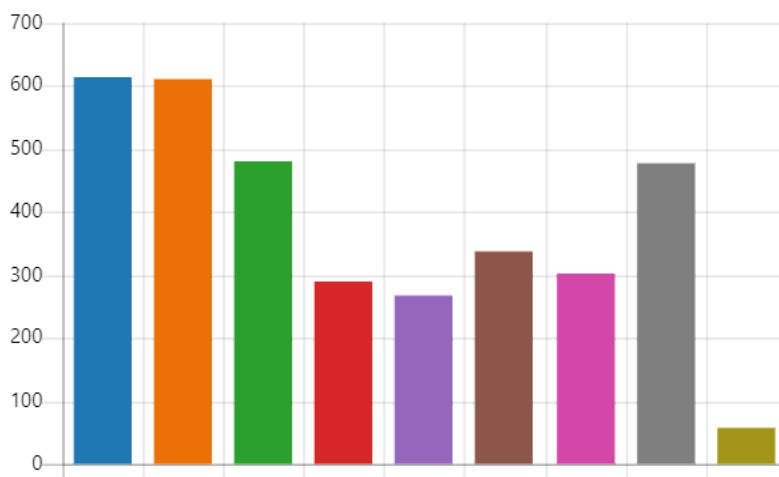
2. If students use their phones in class we intend to address this directly.
