



PHONES AWAY FOR THE DAY AT CHS
The Government regulations require that schools must ensure students do not use or access a phone while they are attending school, including during lunch time and breaks.

IS THE STUDENT USING THE PHONE WITHOUT PERMISSION?

*The phone will be confiscated during learning time.
The phone may be confiscated during break times, depending on the context.*

PHONE/EARBUDS CONFISCATED BY STAFF MEMBER
- Phone/Earbuds are taken to SLT where it will be kept securely.
KAMAR ENTRY: TEACHER

STUDENT REFUSES TO HAND PHONE/EARBUDS OVER
- Send student to SLT/Dean or call for assistance if needed.
KAMAR ENTRY: TEACHER

FIRST OFFENCE
- Student given an After School Detention (Tuesday or Thursday).
- Phone/earbuds are to be handed in to the SLT office **each morning** until the completion of the After School detention.
HOME CONTACT: SLT/DEAN
KAMAR ENTRY: SLT/DEAN

SECOND OFFENCE
- Student given a Saturday detention.
- Phone/earbuds are to be handed in to the SLT office **each morning** until the completion of the Saturday detention.
HOME CONTACT: SLT/DEAN
KAMAR ENTRY: SLT/DEAN

THIRD OFFENCE (OR MORE)
- Offence treated as continual disobedience.
- Consequence could include:
Whare Ora
Section 27
Stand Down
- Phone/earbuds handed in to SLT **each morning for two weeks.**
HOME CONTACT: SLT/DEAN
KAMAR ENTRY: SLT/DEAN

DELIBERATE DISOBEDIENCE
Consequences could include:
- Whare Ora
- Section 27
- Stand Down
